## Accès Bordeaux 2

Le Service Commun de la Documentation (SCD) et l'université Bordeaux 2 ont souscrit une licence auprès de l'éditeur "Silverplatter" permettant un accès gratuit et sans mot de passe à partir de toutes les machines connectées internet du campus aux bases de données bibliographiques précitées.

### ERIC

The ERIC database consists of two files : the Resources in Education (RIE) file of document citations and the Current Index to Journals in Education (CIJE) file of journal article citations from over 750 professional journals. In addition, ERIC now contains over 850 ERIC Digest records that feature the full text of the original document .ERIC (Educational Resources Information Center), is an information system sponsored by the U.S. Department of Education that generates the U.S. national bibliographic database covering the literature of education.

### FRANCIS

L'INIST (INstitut de l'Information Scientifique et Technique) est producteur de la base de données FRANCIS multilingue et multidisciplinaire.

La base de données FRANCIS est une base de données bibliographique contenant 1,5 millions de notices et couvrant les sciences humaines et sociales à l'échelle internationale.

Ces domaines ou bases de données qui la compose comprennent : la Bibliographie de l'Histoire de l'Art [c'est à dire, la Bibliographie de l'Histoire de l'Art (BHA) depuis 1991, et le Répertoire d'Art et d'Archéologie (RAA) 1984-1991], la Psychologie, les Sciences de l'information, l'Administration, l'Amérique latine, l'Archéologie, l'Ethnologie, la Géographie, la Gestion des entreprises, l'Histoire des sciences et des techniques, l'Histoire et les sciences des religions, la Linguistique, la Littérature, la Philosophie, la Préhistoire et la protohistoire, la Sociologie et les Sciences de l'éducation.

Les citations comprennent des articles de périodiques, des comptes rendus de congrès, des monographies, des rapports scientifiques, et des thèses de doctorat.

FRANCIS a une couverture internationale. L'ensemble des langues suivantes peut être représenté dans la base. Vous pouvez aussi bien trouver la référence d'un document primaire écrit en anglais, en français, en portugais, en russe...

### MEDLINE

#### *SilverPlatter MEDLINE(R)*

SilverPlatter MEDLINE(R) is a version of the bibliographic database of the National Library of Medicine (NLM). It includes such topics as microbiology, delivery of health care, nutrition, pharmacology, and environmental health. The categories covered in the database include anatomy, organisms, diseases, chemicals and drugs, techniques and equipment, psychiatry and psychology, biological sciences, physical sciences, social sciences and education, technology, agriculture, food, industry, humanities, information science and communications, and health care.

### PREMEDLINE

#### *PreMedline on SilverPlatter*

PreMedline on SilverPlatter comprises records, provided by the National Library of Medicine (NLM), that have not yet been elevated to completed MEDLINE(R) status. Note that these are strictly in-process records that have not undergone the quality assurance processes a completed MEDLINE(R) record undergoes. Many of the records in this database will become completed MEDLINE(R) records; others will be determined to be out-of-scope for MEDLINE(R) and, therefore, will not be given completed MEDLINE(R) status.

## **SERFILE**

SERFILE (R) on SilverPlatter (R) contains bibliographic information for over 80,000 biomedical and health science serials. The database includes all serials and numbered congresses that are in the National Library of Medicine's collection. A limited number of titles not held by the National Library of Medicine are included if they are indexed in MEDLINE (R), BIOTECHSEEK, or HEALTH. SERFILE provides full title information in MEDLINE and other NLM databases.

## **PASCAL BIOMED**

L'INIST (INstitut de l'Information Scientifique et Technique) est producteur de la base de données PASCAL multilingue et multidisciplinaire qui couvre l'essentiel de la littérature mondiale en Sciences, Technologie et Médecine.

PASCAL BIOMED correspond à la partie biomédicale de PASCAL et traite la médecine, la pharmacologie, la psychologie. Des domaines transversaux comme la Médecine tropicale, la Santé publique, la Toxicologie, le Génie Biomédical y sont particulièrement bien représentés.

Les résumés d'auteurs sont présents dans 75 % des références bibliographiques depuis 1995.

## **PASCAL SCITECH**

L'INIST (INstitut de l'Information Scientifique et Technique) est producteur de la base de données PASCAL multilingue et multidisciplinaire qui couvre l'essentiel de la littérature mondiale en Sciences, Technologie et Médecine.

PASCAL SCITECH correspond à la partie Scientifique et Technique de PASCAL et traite des sciences de l'Ingénieur, de la Chimie, de la Physique, des sciences relatives à la Terre, l'Océan, l'Espace, ainsi que des sciences en général.

La couverture documentaire du CDRom PASCAL SCITECH est internationale et la littérature française et européenne est traitée en priorité.

Les résumés d'auteurs sont présents dans 80 % des références bibliographiques depuis 1995.

## **PsycINFO**

PsycINFO (R) contains citations and summaries of journal articles, book chapters, books, and technical reports, as well as citations to dissertations, all in the field of psychology and psychological aspects of related disciplines, such as medicine, psychiatry, nursing, sociology, education, pharmacology, physiology, linguistics, anthropology, business, and law. Journal coverage, spanning 1887-present, includes international material selected from more than 1,300 periodicals written in over 25 languages. Current chapter and book coverage includes worldwide English-language material published from 1987-present. Over 55,000 references are added annually through regular updates. PsycINFO is produced and copyrighted by the American Psychological Association.

## **Sociological Abstracts**

Sociological Abstracts provides access to the world's literature in sociology and related disciplines, both theoretical and applied. The database includes abstracts of journal articles selected from over 2500 journals, abstracts of conference papers presented at various sociological association meetings, relevant dissertation listings from *Dissertations Abstracts International*, enhanced bibliographic citations of book reviews, and abstracts of selected sociology books.

Approximately 2500 journals in 30 different languages from about 55 countries are scanned for inclusion, covering sociological topics in fields such as anthropology, economics, education, medicine, community development, philosophy, demography, political science, and social psychology. Journals published by sociological associations, groups, faculties, and institutes, and periodicals containing the term "sociology" in their titles, are abstracted fully, irrespective of language or country of publication. Non-core journals are screened for articles by sociologists and/or articles of immediate interest or relevance to sociologists.

### EMBASE

EMBASE is the complete bibliographic database produced by Elsevier Science. It provides access to the world's literature on pharmacology and biomedicine. Emtree, the thesaurus for EMBASE, is an integral part of EMBASE.

### INSPEC Database

INSPEC is one of the most respected databases in the information business, due largely to the quality of the indexing. Coverage includes physics, electrical engineering, electronics, telecommunications, computers, control technology, and information technology. The database contains over 5 million records and approximately 300,000 records are added annually. INSPEC Database, 1969 to present, is compiled and produced by the IEE (Institution of Electrical Engineers) in association with FIZ Karlsruhe.

### INIS

INIS, the International Nuclear Information System, is an international bibliographic database. It is produced by the International Atomic Energy Agency (IAEA), Vienna, Austria, in collaboration with participating countries and international organizations. INIS is the world's leading information system on the peaceful uses of nuclear science and technology. INIS maintains a database containing currently over 2 million bibliographic references and announces the availability of scientific literature published world-wide on the peaceful uses of nuclear energy. It also maintains a collection of full text non-conventional (grey) literature that would be difficult to obtain elsewhere. All aspects of the peaceful uses of nuclear science and technology are covered. There are central areas to the scope such as nuclear reactors, reactor safety, nuclear fusion, applications of radiation and radioisotopes in medicine, agriculture, industry and pest control as well as related fields such as nuclear chemistry, nuclear physics and materials science. Special emphasis is placed on the environmental, economic and health effects of nuclear energy. Legal and social aspects associated with nuclear energy are also covered. And, from 1992, the economic and environmental aspects of all non-nuclear energy sources are included in the scope.
